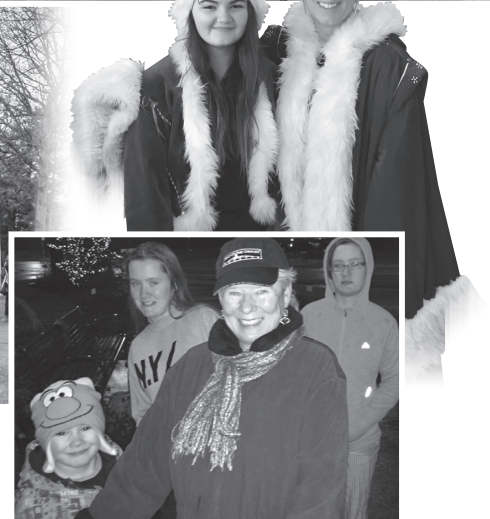

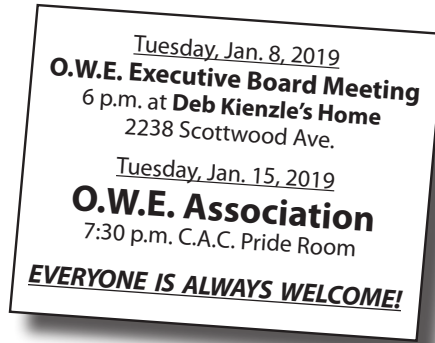


Happy 2019, Old West End neighbors! Congratulations on surviving another holiday season—I hope 2019 is your best year yet.
