

Some of the crimes that can be reported online using COPRS: Criminal Damage/Criminal Mischief; Criminal Damage to Vehicle; Criminal Trespass; Disorderly Conduct; Telephone Harassment; Theft up to \$1,000 MONTHLY EMAIL REPORTS - We are offering a monthly email report to all regular supporters/subscribers. This includes incidents the patrols have encountered, anything reported to us, along with general news and updates. Supporters, please let us know your preferred email address if you would like to receive this in your Inbox by emailing us: OldWestEndSecurity@gmail.com.

DID YOU KNOW? - Supporters get 7 FREE days of vacation checks a year. A vacation check entails the patrols to get out of the vehicle and walk the perimeter of your home checking to make sure it is secure and safe. To take advantage of this, please contact our Resident Manager: (419) 902-0982 or OldWestEndSecurity@gmail.com. REMINDER - OWES patrols add an extra set of eyes on our homes and streets. The mere presence of the patrols make our neighborhood as inhospitable for crime




